Tournament Rules

1. There will be registration/sign-in at the Tournament site starting at 5:30am. Registration will close at 6:30am. Registration will be at the pavilion on top of the hill just before getting to the ramp at the State Park (Look for signs). Entry fee is \$70 per boat with an optional \$10 Big Bass pot. Entry fees paid on the morning of the tournament must be made in cash. Early entry fees may be paid by check. Make checks payable to Sparrow Early Childhood Center.
2. All early applications and entry fees are to be turned in to

3. No more than (2) two anglers per boat (at least 1 adult 18 years old).
4. ALL Kentucky Boating and Wildlife Laws must be obeyed concerning fish size, species and limit.
5. ONLY Species allowed in tournament: Largemouth Bass, Smallmouth Bass, & Kentucky Bass.
6. No live or prepared bait. Artificial lures only. No trolling.
7. All live wells will be checked before the tournament begins.
8. There will be a FIVE fish limit per team
9. All fish should be kept alive and in the best shape possible, then released after weigh-in. Weigh-in is at 3:00pm EST
 - There will also be a ½ lb. deduction for each dead fish.
 - All boats not in by 3:00pm will be disqualified.
10. Fish must measure 15 inches on Golden Rule, mouth closed. All live fish to be returned to the lake.

- A courtesy check Golden Rule will be available.
 - Weighing of a short fish will result in disqualification.
11. In the event that the tournament has to be cancelled, applicants will be notified and all entry fees will be refunded.
 12. Starting positions will be determined by the order in which your application and entry fee are received.
 13. All Entry Fees must accompany entry forms. Once entry fees are received, team captains will be contacted to confirm your starting position a week before the tournament.
 14. In the event of a tie, tiebreakers will be determined by the team with the biggest fish.
 15. U.S. Coast Guard approved Life Jackets are required while combustion engine is above idle.
 16. Tournament officials are permitted to fish event.
 17. Fish must be caught on the tournament lake during official tournament hours.
 18. The no wake zone at the Marina and the ramp area at Possum Ridge are off limits for the tournament. The creek to the left of Possum Ridge ramp may be fished starting at the post/marker and the creek to the right of Possum Ridge ramp may be fished starting at the end of the sidewalk. (Off limit areas will be reviewed prior to the launch of the tournament)
 19. No one may leave his or her boat to fish or land a fish.
 20. If any of the above rules are broken, this will result in immediate disqualification and no entry fees will be refunded.
