Tournament Rules & Regulations

1. Registration will close minutes prior to launch the day of the tournament, which will occur at safe light.
2. Entry fee is \$70 **cash** the day of the tournament (checks/money orders are accepted by mail in advance).
3. No more than **two** fishermen per boat with at least one adult 18 years old.
4. All boat owners must carry a minimum of \$100k liability insurance.
5. **All** Kentucky boating and Wildlife Laws must be obeyed.
6. Only black-bass species will be weighed in, including largemouth, smallmouth, and Kentucky bass.
7. No one may use live bait (pork trailers may be used), **artificial lures only**. No trolling allowed, only one rod used at a time.
8. All boats must be equipped with working live wells.
9. There will be a FIVE fish limit per team. All bass must be 15 inches in length with the exception of one allowed slot (12-15 inches) unless otherwise stated at the pre-tournament meeting. Kentucky bass must be at least 12 inches in length. Five Kentucky bass greater than 12 inches can constitute to a limit. Determination of Kentucky Bass will be made by the Tournament Director considering closed jaw commencing before the eye and the patch on the tongue.
10. All fish should be kept alive and in the best shape possible, then released after weigh in. If late, there will be a .5 lb deduction for every minute late up to 15 minutes, disqualified after 15 minutes - no exceptions. There will also be a .25 lb deduction for each dead fish weighed in, and a .5 lb deduction for every short fish brought to the scales.
11. Purse will be decided after all entry fees have been received. Total payout will be 70%, 30% goes to the club. Big Fish Pot will pay out 100% to the angler catching the heaviest bass in the tournament.
12. Starting positions will be determined by the order in which registration is completed. Tiebreakers will be determined by the team who has the largest fish, if a tie still exists ties will be broken in accordance with Rule 19 of the *2010 Bass Federation Official Tournament Rules*.
13. Lifejackets must be worn at **ALL** times while the combustion engine is in gear. Kill switch must be operational and used when combustion engine is in operation.
14. All anglers will be responsible for any ramp fees.
15. If any of the above rules are broken during the competition, the team may be immediately **disqualified**.

17. Sportsman like conduct must be observed at all times. The Tournament Director reserves the right to enforce any rules not listed on this form.
