- ½ lb. penalty per dead fish. Dead fish can not be weighted for big fish (officials will determine dead fish and decision in final)
- No culling inside buoys at tournament site
- Must have working live well
- No trolling
- Largemouth, Smallmouth, and Kentucky bass only
- Artificial bait only
- Any rule appeals must be brought to the tournament officials' in a timely and orderly manner. Tournament director will decide upon the appeal.
- Boaters must follow all state and federal regulations. Please use good lake etiquette.
- Only one (1) rod may be used at a time. Other rods may be in the boat and ready for use, however, every cast and retrieve must be completed before another cast is made
