**HOOKED ON SCOUTING
BASS TOURNAMENT RULES &
REGULATIONS**

1. All boats must meet all Coast Guard requirements and have an areated livewell(s).
2. No more than two contestants per boat.
3. Only large mouth, small mouth, and spotted bass will be weighed.
4. Only fish measuring 15 inches for large mouth, spotted and small mouth bass with mouth closed may be weighed.
5. Only artificial baits may be used and there may be no trolling.
6. Five fish limit per boat.
7. There will be a 4-ounce penalty for each dead fish.
8. There will be a late penalty of 1 pound per minute. Any angler more than 15 minutes late will lose all fish.
9. Each contestant is required to wear a fastened U.S. Coast Guard-approved personal flotation devise anytime the combustion engine is in operation.
10. Livewells will be checked by tournament committee prior to start of tournament.
11. Fish will be weighed in provided official bags only.
12. Ties will be broken by number of fish in stringer, then by number of live fish in stringer. After that, money will be combined and split between tied boats.
13. Any protests must be made in writing within 15 minutes of the tournament's end.
14. No alcohol during tournament hours or on tournament site.
15. Decisions of tournament committee will be final.
